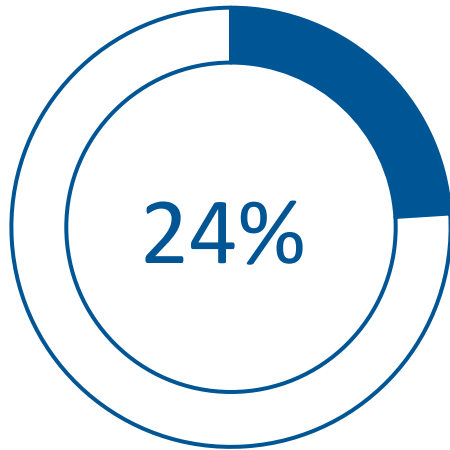
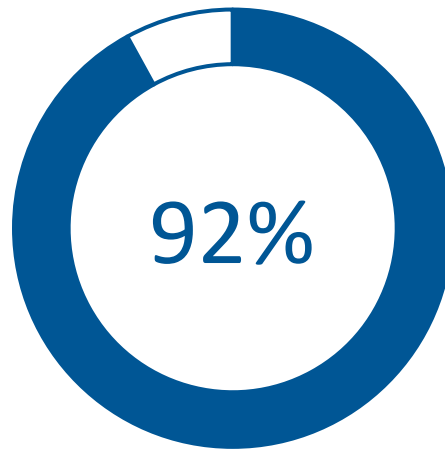


GATX Supplier Sustainability Data

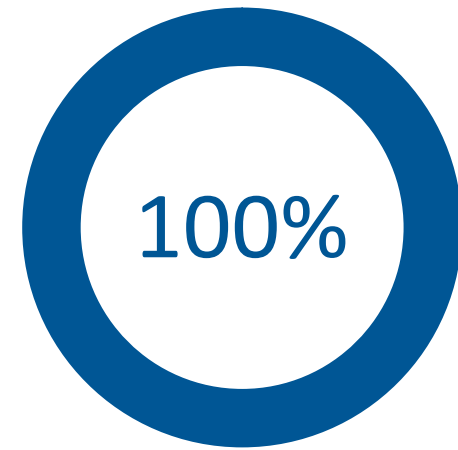


Suppliers with ISO 14001 or equivalent environmental management system certification



Supplier compliance* rate with environmental, health, and safety policies

*Compliance defined by having no environmental or safety enforcement action (i) material to the company's business or financial condition or (ii) resulting in a fine in excess of \$100,000



Supplier compliance* rate with labor rights policies

*Compliance defined by having no fines, prosecution, or warnings by Federal, state, or local agency with regard to child labor, forced labor, or other
